It's time to lace up those running shoes and begin training for the **Marathon Bahamas Race Weekend!** To be held January 15-16, 2011, the schedule includes the Susan G. Komen Race for the Cure on Saturday followed by Marathon Bahamas on Sunday. If you're wondering why anyone would want to run 26 miles in the tropics, the average January temperature in Nassau is a very pleasant 66.5 degrees. The Komen race is a 5k (3.1 mile) race that will take place at 6:00 a.m. Saturday on Paradise Island; both individual and team entries will be accepted. The race raises funds for Susan G. Komen for the Cure, the world's largest breast cancer organization. Additional information about the foundation, breast health and breast cancer may be found at [www.komen.org](http://www.komen.org). Marathon Bahamas consists of a 13.1 mile half-marathon and a full 26.2 mile marathon (which includes a 6-member team event). Sunday's events begin at Junkanoo Beach (west of downtown) and end at Arawak Cay (just a short walk from the start). The marathon course will take runners through historic areas and showcase the beauty of New Providence and Paradise Islands before bringing participants to an idyllic oceanfront finish. 
## What Can I Do On My Vacation?

As noted in our Summer edition, Paradise Island and neighboring Nassau are full of interesting and exciting attractions and sightseeing opportunities, most of which are a short walk or taxi ride away. Golf, historic forts, water sports and unique shopping adventures are just a few of the activities available. Our Concierge Department (800 552-2839 extension 235) can assist you if you prefer organized tours. But the area also hosts multiple exciting one-of-a-kind events all through the year. We've highlighted a few of them below:

Nassau has a brand new culture and arts festival – **CariFringe!** This ten day event will take place October 1st through the 11th and will offer a huge variety of entertainment options including art exhibits, concerts, literary readings, craft markets, theatrical productions and workshops. Artists and craftsmen from the Bahamas as well as various parts of the Caribbean will be in attendance, giving the festival a pan-West Indies feel. Major events include the Commencement Grand Rue Gala on Thursday, September 30th (a ticketed semi-formal beach party featuring music, entertainment and Caribbean food) and The Grand Market which will serve as the festival's central location. The festival ties in with Shakespeare in Paradise (see page 2). Be sure to make your reservations at Club Land'or for October and enjoy an intriguing glimpse into the unique culture and mores of the Caribbean people.

If you know the difference between a grapple tackle and a dump tackle, then you'll definitely want to be in Nassau on the week of October 14 – 17 for the **Bahamas Masters Rugby Festival**. The sport featured in the hit movie *Invictus* is coming to Winton Rugby Centre for four days of smash-mouth excitement. The event will feature two divisions: a competitive Over 30 grouping and a social Over 40 bracket. For those unfamiliar with the sport, rugby is often called "the toughest sport in the world". Two teams of 13 players (with no helmets or padding) attempt to move a spheroid-shaped ball the length of a rectangular grass field, carrying or kicking the ball towards the opponent's goal line where points can be scored by grounding the ball (called a try) then kicking a conversion goal for extra points. The opponents attempt to stop the movement of the ball by tackling the player carrying it. Also, the ball may only be passed sideways or backward. Rugby bears a slight resemblance to American football, making it a little easier to understand than other sports played in the Caribbean such as cricket. The sport is wildly popular in countries such as England and New Zealand; now you can experience a sport that thrills millions of fans worldwide. Come to the festival, pick a team and cheer them on...you're sure to gain respect for this gritty, hard-played game!
